The Douglas Lake Volunteer Boat Assistance Team will again be available during the 2018 boating season running from approximately May 19 through September 9, 2018. The DL Volunteer Boat Assistance Team consists of your friends and neighbors residing on Douglas Lake. Team members are not professional boat mechanics, but are willing to lend a hand if you become stranded on DL due to a malfunctioning boat or motor.

Below are the names and telephone numbers of the team members. There is a directional designation next to the member's telephone number indicating where the member lives on the lake. If you need assistance please call a team member living near the location where you are stranded. Tell the team member the type of problem you are experiencing, your location, describe your boat and the number of people on board. The US Coast Guard always recommends for all people on board to put on a life jacket if they are experiencing a boating problem.
