Good Neighbor Practices

PLEASE

Pets	Pick up after your pet on private property and public walkways. Remember that a constantly barking dog can be a source of irritation to your neighbors.
Lights	Outdoor lights should be shielded and aimed downward. They should not shine in your neighbor's windows. Turn off outdoor lights when not actively in use.
Roads	For everyone's safety, please drive the speed limit or less. Be considerate of walkers, dog walkers, bicyclists, horseback riders and horse-drawn carriages on our roads.
Household waste	Recycle. Wait until your assigned trash pickup day to put bags out. Use sturdy locked containers to protect bags. If you need to leave, ask a neighbor for help.
Beach/Yard Fires	Be aware of DNR's fire level and attend a fire with a means of extinguishing readily on hand.
Jet Skis/Wake Boats	Be considerate of bottomland/shoreline/dock damage from continuous high wakes too close to shore. Use less-populated areas of lake for extended jet ski/wake boat use.
Fireworks	Restrict fireworks to the appropriate holidays between dusk and 11 p.m.
